# Special Exhibitions 2017

### Gallery 6:

**Thatcham Remembered** - A study through old photographs from the museum collection. Thatcham Camera Club's photographs compare old scenes of Thatcham to today's view. Runs until 18 June 2017



**Trophies & Tractors** - A look at the history of the Royal County of Berkshire Show, from its humble beginnings in 1909 to today's highly respected agricultural and rural event. Starts 30 June



## Gallery 7:

**Boxford Masques** - An exhibition which traces the fascinating history of this renowned drama group which can trace its roots back over a 100 years. Runs until 24 April (Free workshop at the museum Saturday 4 March)



**Crime & Punishment** - A history of crime in West Berkshire with illustrated accounts of crime and punishment from the Martyrs of Newbury to the last use of stocks in the local area. Starts 3 May



### Gallery 8:

**Something Old, Something New** - Crinolines, bustles, bows and frills, they're all here, even a crochet dress made in Northbrook Street. This exhibition tracks the changing designs of fashion through time. Runs until 30 November



### Gallery 9:

**The Lie of the Land** - A collection of paintings of the landscape around West Berkshire from romantic oil paintings of a farmer walking in the Berkshire Downs from the early 1900's to more recent townscapes. Runs until 27 August



### Gallery 10:

**Cabinets of Curiosity** - Taking inspiration from the long history of 'Cabinets of Curiosity', we have gathered together our own collection of strange and wonderful things from the collection. Runs until 31 December
