### Museum damp works project

West Berkshire Museum is undergoing a project to **resolve the damp issue** in key areas, including the Long Room (traditionally utilised for school sessions, family activities and other events).

This project is provisionally **planned for autumn/winter** (and potentially into 2026) and although we are hoping to keep the Museum open during this period as well as run some events, we have made the difficult decision <u>not</u> to host any school visits to the Museum while the work is being undertaken. We are however planning to run events such as the Roman Family and School Days.
