

## How to make a Spring hat

What you will need at the start:

**Two strips of card, which can come from a cereal box or similar. One wide strip and one narrow;**

**A pair of scissors; sticky tape; felt tips pens or paint (optional).**

- (1) Use the scissors to cut a zig-zag or wavy pattern along the long edge of the wide strip of card. This is the top of your hat. Colour in if you wish. Now use the sticky tape to attach the narrow strip of card to the hat to make a band that can be adjusted to size later. Colour in if you wish.

- (2) **Now you can start to decorate your hat.**

What you will need:

**Pieces of paper and/or card; a glue stick; sticky tape; felt tip pens, stickers and any other craft materials you have.**

- (a) You can make your own **flowers**. If you want a five petal flower, cut out a starlike shape. After you have done this, cut another starlike shape, but make it smaller, if you can. This could have five or four petals. When you have done this use the glue stick to stick the smaller petal shape on top of the other. The flower needs a **stalk**. For this, cut a thin strip of paper or use a pipe cleaner and glue the flower to the top. Then, glue or use sticky tape the stalk on the back of your hat. You can make more than one

(b) You can also make flowers to stick to the front of your hat. If you like, you can make a **bee, ladybird, butterfly or any other insect** to add to your hat!

To make your insect, **you will need a black felt-tipped pen and a piece of paper/card**. Cut an oval shape out of the paper/card and colour in if you wish. Use your pen to mark the shape to make it look like a bee or a ladybird. If you have made a bee, give it some wings so it can fly! You can cut the wings out of paper or card too and stick them to the underside of the bee. Stick your bee on the hat. Or, you could make another 'stalk' and glue the bee to the end to make it look as if it is flying!
