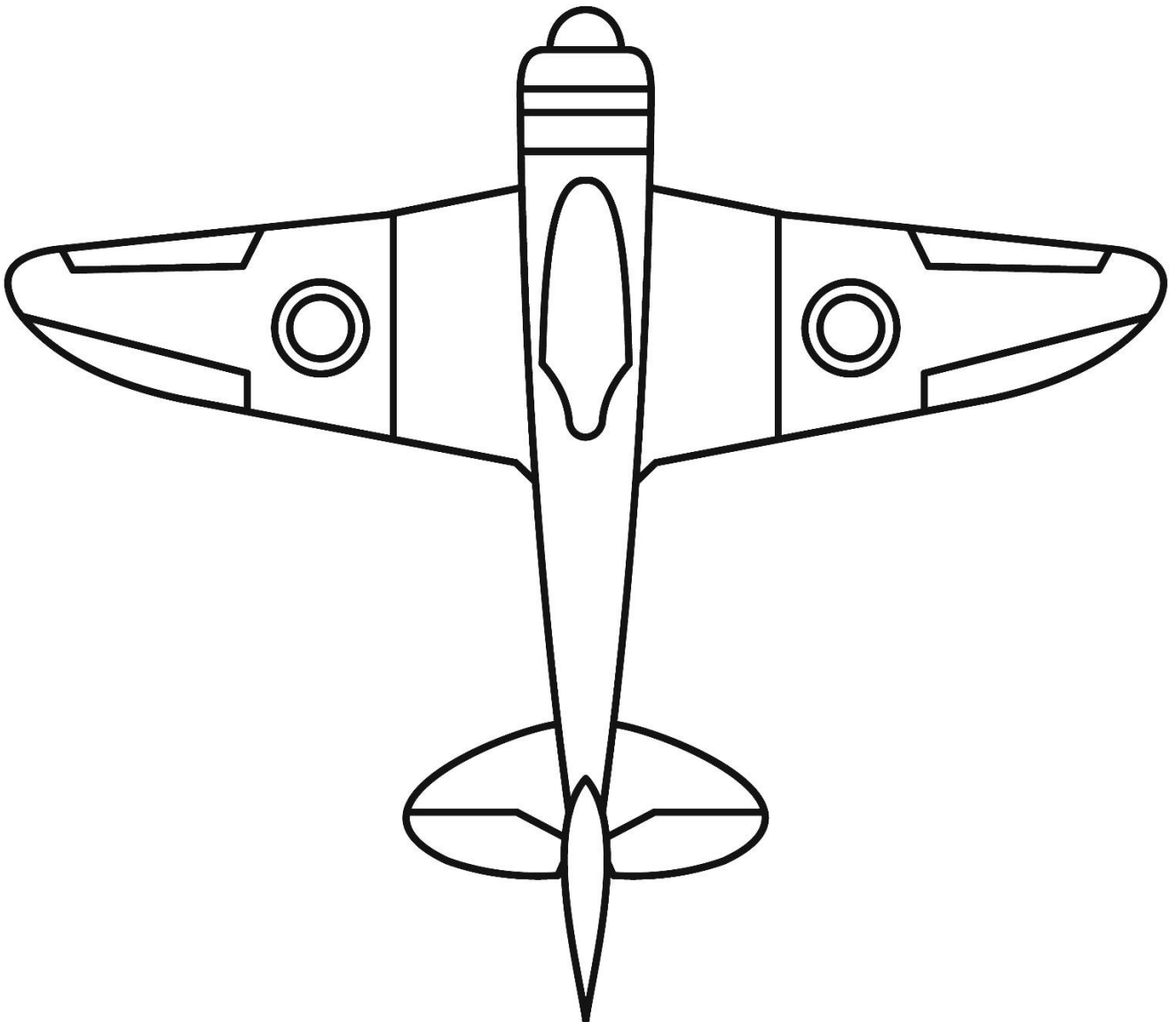


Design and colour in a World War II plane

The three main types of planes used in the Second World War were fighters, bombers and transport planes. Fighter planes were designed for air-to-air combat and were usually equipped with machine guns and cannons. One of the most famous fighters is the British Spitfire. Bombers were larger planes made to carry and drop bombs over enemy targets; an example of this type of plane is the British Lancaster. Transport planes also had an important role to play in carrying supplies and troops to different parts of the world.
