Exhibitions at West Berkshire Museum

Special exhibition: Villa. Looking through the eyes of a fictional Roman family in their villa we explore our ancestors' lives and legacy. **Open until July 2021.**

Special exhibition: Focus on Stratfield Mortimer. This exhibition will explore Stratfield Mortimer's history and archaeology through objects from the Museum collection and loans from the local community. Open until July. Special exhibition: Hoards – New Treasure. An exhibition bringing together over eleven hoards (buried treasure) from different periods, all found in West Berkshire. Open until end of July 2021.

Special exhibition: Place to Place. Sharing the stories of journeys taken to, from and around West Berkshire. **Open and runs until 22 Nov 2020.**

Gallery 5: A Time and A Place. Newbury College Art and Design students showcase artwork inspired by a visit to West Berkshire Museum. **Open and closes on 26th April 2020.**

Lives and Landscape. Our permanent exhibition tells the story of West Berkshire, from local characters such as Jack of Newbury to events such as the Newbury coat, A34 bypass and Civil War battles. Open. It is free to do a self-led visit of the exhibitions and free activity trails can be provided too. If given enough notice, a trail can be tailor-made for your visit; this service is free.
