
Creative writing challenge: Aerodome

Shalcraft in his car, an American vehicle, beside a CG-13 glider, Crookham Common aerodrome, in 1944. This photograph is from an album made by John Brown, then aged 15 years old, who was a frequent visitor to the aerodrome in early 1944.
