This is a hand-painted invitation card. It includes a painting of a river valley. It was painted by Archer Poole around 1923. Archer Poole was a shop assistant at Webb's Provision Merchants in Newbury. This invitation is one of twelve invitation cards by Archer Poole in the museum collection, sent to the woman who would later become his wife, Emmie Poole.
