

Colour in a hoard

This is the Crow Down hoard, found by a metal detectorist on the Lambourn Downs in 2004. It is five gold items of personal adornment: three undecorated bangles or bracelets, and two twisted items that were probably worn around the top of the arm or neck. They would have been high status items so the person who wore them was someone of importance.
