This is a replica (copy) of a skull of 'The Piltdown Man'. This was a fraud by amateur archaeologist Charles Dawson in the early twentieth century, who claimed that he had uncovered bone fragments of a previously unknown early man; the 'missing link' between ape and man. The truth was not uncovered until 1950s, over 40 years later.
