
Colour in a socketed axe



This is a socketed axe, part of the Yattendon Hoard dating to the Bronze Age. It is a complete socketed axe with side loop and widely splayed, rounded blade. One of the splayed tips of the cutting edge has broken off.

Using felt tip pens or colouring pencils, colour in the axe.
