
Colour in a gramophone



This is a clockwork gramophone player manufactured by HMV (The Gramophone Company Ltd) around 1928, with a record cleaning pad, a tin box of needles and a card wallet of needles. The stained oak base has double doors opening to reveal three shelves for storing records. The open doors acted as an amplifier.

Using felt tip pens or colouring pencils, colour in the gramophone.
