



Colour in a smock

This is a nineteenth century smock. A smock was worn by farm workers and was a loose linen garment. A farm labourer would usually have an everyday smock and a smarter smock for 'Sunday Best'. It is called a 'smock' after the type of stitching (smocking) used to decorate it.

Using felt tip pens or colouring pencils, colour in the smock.
