
Colour in a collared urn



This collared urn dates from the Bronze Age. Most urns are found in round barrows (burial places) and this one is no exception. It was found in a round barrow at Inkpen. Barrows dot the landscape of this area, the most famous being the Seven Barrows at Lambourn.
