Dinosaur! Make a Cetiosaurus

This dinosaur is simple to make from basic craft materials.

You will need: cardboard roll, pencil, scissors, white and green paint, paintbrush(es), fine nib permanent marker (black).

Instructions:

1. Use a pencil to draw your dinosaur on the cardboard roll. Please see the pictures below (from left to right: front, back and sides). Cut out with scissors.







- 2. Paint the dinosaur in green (inside and out). Leave to dry.
- 3. Bend the front of the dinosaur to form the head.
- 4. Gently shape the back of the dinosaur to form a curved tail.
- 5. Draw on the eyes using the fine nib permanent marker.
- 6. Add details (to the eyes and feet) using white paint. Leave to dry.
- 7. Your dinosaur is ready to roam! Imagine some adventures for your dinosaur.

Fun facts: This dinosaur is based on a Cetiosaurus, which lived in England during the mid-Jurassic (170-160 million years ago). It was a type of dinosaur called a sauropod and was a plant-eater. It could grow to be up to 18 metres in length!
